

INDUSTRIAL PLUMBING & ASSOCIATED SERVICES

- Installation of new pipelines for plant and services (Process water, potable water, fire services).
- High-density polyethylene (HDPE) poly welding and pipe spooling.
- Critical leak repairs

TRACK RECORD | CRITICAL DELIVERABLES

CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE: HDPE DEWATERING LINE REPAIR

- **Scope:** Emergency excavation and repair of an aged 600mm HDPE dewatering pipeline critical to mine operations. The scope included complex deep excavation with safety benching, removal of compromised sections, and precision onsite specialised poly welding of new pipework.
- **The Arco Difference:** Our team executed high-risk earthworks and welding within a strict shutdown window. The result was no downtime to the fixed plant and mining operations, restoring full capacity ahead of schedule.

ASSET INTEGRITY: SITE-WIDE CONCRETE REMEDIATION

- **Scope:** Ongoing execution of defect rectifications based on detailed structural inspections. Work involves the expert selection and application of advanced epoxy and grout products to address spalling, cracking, and structural degradation.
- **The Arco Difference:** We don't just fix the defects; we manage the compliance. Arco provides a full suite of QA/QC paperwork for every repair, ensuring the client has a perfect audit trail. Our deep knowledge of material specifications ensures the right product is used for the harsh Pilbara conditions.

NPI: TURNKEY OFFICE COMPLEX INSTALLATION

- **Scope:** End-to-end installation of a new site office complex, located in Greenbushes, WA. Arco managed the entire package, including civil footings, heavy lift crange, complex placement, and full integration of services (electrical, plumbing, and communications).
- **The Arco Difference:** Agility in delivery. When the client's requirements shifted mid-project, Arco adapted the scope immediately without halting progress. We worked collaboratively to redesign the service layout, delivering exactly what the client needed rather than just what was on the original drawing.
